ACROSS

get across
communicate clearly

"He couldn't get his point across during the meeting."

DOWN TO

get down to
start doing seriously

"I must get down to planning my trip today"

AWAY WITH

get away with
escape punishment

"They got away with not paying the ticket to the bus"

BACK TO

get back to
respond later

"Can I get back to you tomorrow about that?"

THROUGH

get through
succeed / finish a challenge

"She got through her finals quite easily."

ON WITH

get on with
continue doing something

"Let's get on with it, no more delays."

ON

get on
manage / deal with

"How are you getting on the new project?"

AROUND

get around
go to places / move

"You need a car to get around easily in this city."
