come back
return

BACK

"She came back home late last night."

IN

come in
enter

"Come in and take a seat, please."

come along
accompany someone

ALONG

"Do you want to come along with us?"

APART

come apart
fall to pieces

"The old book came apart when I opened it."

come down
decrease

DOWN

"Temperatures usually come down in autumn."

OVER

come over
visit someone's house

"My cousins are coming over this evening."

come down with
become sick

DOWN WITH

"He came down with a cold yesterday."

ON

come on
encourage, or disbelief, interjection

"Come on, let's go!"
"Come on, that can't be true!"
