OFF

run off
escape quickly

"The thief ran off before we could catch him."

TO

run to
reach a certain amount

"The repairs ran to 3000 euros."

OFF WITH

run off with
steal and escape

"He ran off with both our bags."

OVER

run over
review quickly / hit with a vehicle

*"Let's run over the plan again."
"The dog was run over by a truck."*

AGAINST

run against
oppose in an election

"She ran against her ex-husband in the mayoral race."

UP AGAINST

run up against
face difficulties

"We ran up against some serious problems last week."

BY

run by
ask for approval/comments

"I'll run the text by you before publishing."

ON

run on
function with a type of fuel / power

"This car runs on diesel."
