IN

put in
install

"They put in a new heating system."

OUT

put out
extinguish

"Please put out the candle before you go to sleep."

OFF

put off
postpone / disgust

"We had to put off the trip because of bad weather."

"The smell of vinegar really puts me off, I can't eat that."

ASIDE

put aside
save for later / ignore temporarily

"We've put money aside for travel."

"Put your differences aside and work together, be professional."

THROUGH

put through
connect by phone

"Please wait while I put you through Mr. Williams."

FORWARD

put forward
suggest an idea

"He's putting forward a new plan next meeting."

ACROSS

put across
communicate clearly

"She put her message across very well yesterday."

UP WITH

put up with
tolerate

"I can't put up with this noise anymore."
