OBJECT PRONOUNS

ME You see **me**.

YOU I speak to **you**.

THEM We see **them**.

POSSESSIVE PRONOUNS

MINE This book is **mine**.

YOURS This book is **yours**.

HERS This book is **hers**.

HIS This book is **his**.

ITS Look at this building.
Its windows are big.

OURS The building is **ours**.

YOURS The house is **yours**.

THEIRS The building is **theirs**.

REFLEXIVE PRONOUNS

MYSELF I see **myself** in the mirror.

YOURSELF You see **yourself** in the mirror.

HERSELF She sees **herself** in the mirror.

HIMSELF He sees **himself** in the mirror.

ITSELF This building protects **itself**
from storms, it's very modern.

OURSELVES We see **ourselves** in the mirror.

YOURSELVES You see **yourselves** in the mirror.

THEMSELVES They sees **themselves** in the mirror.

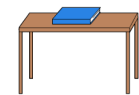
