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B2-C1 - Upper-Intermediate



make into
transform into something

INTO

"They made the garage into an office"

make of (something)
understand, interpret

OF

"What do you make of his comment?"

make out
understand, kiss romantically

OUT

"I couldn't make out what they were saying."

"They made out at the back of the car."

make off (with)
escape, often after stealing

OFF

"The suspect made off before the cops arrived at the scene."

"The suspect made off with all the cash."

make (someone) out
recognize, understand clearly

OUT

"I couldn't make her out in the crowd."

make for
contribute to, move towards

FOR

"Clear communication makes for better teamwork."

make over
renovate

OVER

"We made over the apartment last year."

make towards
move in the direction of

**TO
WARDS**

"She quietly made towards the door."
